Our walkthrough enclosures are undoubtedly some of the most popular attractions at the Zoo. We have Lemur Woods, Wallaby Walkabout and Parrots of the World. Visitors have the opportunity to enter the enclosure where these animals live and observe them more closely than through a barrier.

We are looking for enthusiastic volunteers to help provide our guests with a fun and informative visit into one of our many walk-through enclosures.

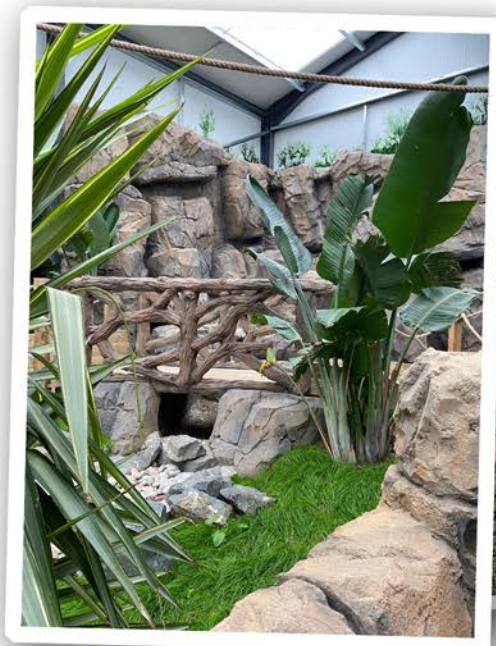
Lemur Woods is home to a group of ring-tailed and red fronted lemurs. Our new 'Parrots of the World', opening in Spring 2022, will be house free-flying blue and gold macaws as well as blue fronted amazon and African grey parrots situated in a tropical planted house.

Each walk-through enclosure is open for a few hours every day, so this role would suit someone who has a few spare hours but perhaps not the whole day. Walk-through volunteers would be required between 10:00 and 14:00 and would spend time in both walk-through enclosures.

This role is one of the less physically demanding roles in the Zoo, but perfect if you love spending time with animals and talking to people about them!

Volunteering under the supervision of the Head and Deputy Head Keepers, walk-through volunteers will receive full training in order to monitor the behaviour of the animals, advise visitors and answer questions from guests.
